Assault Rack Instructions & Guidelines

## Before assembling the Assault Rack

- » Iron Edge will not be held responsible for any injury or death that occurs while installing or using this product.
- » Each Assault Rack is laser-cut from steel. Be aware that internal edges can be sharp or abrasive and should be treated with caution while assembling.
- » Check the product for any manufacturing defects prior to installation and use. If defects are evident, do not construct or use the product and contact Iron Edge immediately.
- » Follow installation manual for correct installation procedures.

## Product care

- » Store the Assault Rack in a dry environment (unless electroplated for outdoor use).
- » Frequently check that all bolts and fasteners are secure
- » If the powder coat is chipped, use touch-up paint to prevent any corrosion of the exposed raw steel.
- » See each individual product guideline sheet for information on j-cups, spotting arms and utility pegs.

## Lifetime Product Warranty

- » The Assault Rack is covered by a lifetime warranty for manufacturers' defects and faults.
- » Iron Edge will exchange/replace/refund to the customer's satisfaction all Assault Racks affected by manufacturers defects.
- » This warranty does not include normal wear and tear including scratches and chips to the powder coat.
